- The **Orange County Convention Center's** drive-thru testing site will convert to a state operated site, and criteria to qualify for a COVID-19 test has been expanded. Testing is available to individuals with respiratory symptoms and pre-existing medical conditions, regardless of age; all first responders and healthcare workers, regardless of symptoms; and now, anyone who has had close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, even if they are not currently experiencing symptoms. The site also now supports a daily limit of 400 tests, up from the previous cap of 250 per day. Additional information from Orange County [here](#). Testing site directions and map [here](#).

Around The Horn.

- **Mayor Buddy Dyer** announced that the **Amway Center** has become a distribution center for medical equipment and supplies as part of the ongoing response to the coronavirus pandemic. The arena will be a hub for equipment and supplies that will go to [50 hospitals in Central Florida as well as facilities in seven other states](#).
- Originally set for July 3-5 at Lahinch GC in Ireland, the **Arnold Palmer Cup** – an annual match between the best American and international college golfers – [has been rescheduled to take place](#) at **Arnold Palmer's Bay Hill Club & Lodge** on December 21-23.
- Despite the **NWSL** training moratorium and delayed season opener, **Orlando Pride** executive vice president **Amanda Duffy** remains confident [the league will be able to reschedule](#) every game of the 2020 season.
- The **Orlando Magic** broadcasting team, including **Nick Anderson, Scott Anez and Brandon Kravitz**, have started an [online donation drive that will continue through April 30](#) to help raise funds for the Christian Service Center and Second Harvest Food Bank of Central Florida.
- **Riot Games** and **ESPN** have struck a deal to televise the **League of Legends Championship Series (LCS) Spring Split Playoffs** immediately; a notable new example of [a media network turning to esports](#) amid the coronavirus pandemic.
- **Major League Soccer** is "extremely unlikely" to resume play in mid-May, as had been previously targeted, [the league said in a statement released Tuesday](#).

- Four players remain in the **NBA HORSE Challenge** after the first round. [The semifinals and championship](#) will air beginning at 9 p.m. ET April 16 on **ESPN** and streaming on the **ESPN App**.

- New **UCF President Alexander Cartwright** began his tenure on Monday, April 13. Though his arrival comes during a difficult time, he and his wife Melinda [shared a warm greeting and message of hope](#) with Knight Nation.
- **Orlando Health** is partnering with **UCF** and 3D printing company **Stratasys**, leading an effort to [rapidly 3D-print critical personal protective equipment](#) to ensure supplies are available for local healthcare professionals.
- **Orlando Sentinel's Mike Bianchi** spoke to former **Orlando City** coach Adrian Heath, who remembers very well [how sports helped the Orlando community begin healing](#) after tragedy and knows sports will rise to the occasion again.
- With Floridians ordered to stay home, **FDOT** officials are taking advantage of reduced traffic across the state to put infrastructure projects - [including a 21-mile stretch of I-4 in Orange and Seminole Counties](#) - in the fast lane.
- Although the coronavirus canceled Knight-Thon, an annual in-person 20-hour dance marathon and fundraising event that benefits **Arnold Palmer Hospital for Children**, **UCF** students [gathered virtually instead and raised more than \\$865,000](#).

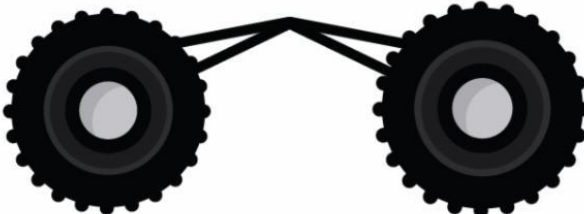
