- **Florida Governor Ron DeSantis** announced Wednesday that [most of Florida will enter what he called “phase one” of the reopening process](#) on **Monday, May 4**.
- **Orange County restaurants and shops** [can open on Monday if they follow Governor DeSantis' new order](#), **Mayor Jerry Demings** said today. The mayor said committees from his **Orange County Economic Recovery Task Force** will continue their work and will hopefully meet the Friday deadline he set to provide recommendations. The county's 11 pm to 5am curfew will also remain in place.
