- The **Orange County Economic Recovery Task Force** [announced seven guidelines](#) for reopening businesses and industries in the Orlando region. **Orange County** has also [developed re-opening criteria for restaurants in unincorporated Orange County](#).
- **Orlando Mayor Buddy Dyer** announced a package of actions that are effective immediately in the **City of Orlando**, providing opportunities for [businesses to temporarily expand their operational space and market their businesses outside](#), without the need to obtain city permits or pay any fees.
- The **PPE for Small Biz in Orange County Initiative** provides personal protective equipment (PPE) to small businesses in **Orange County** to assist in reopening or sustaining operations, at no cost, through **Friday, May 15**. Kits will be distributed to eligible small businesses at drive-through pick-up sites located throughout the county. [Small business owners must fill out an online interest form to register](#).
- Now through **September 1**, patrons can enjoy FREE parking in metered street spaces and inside specific **City of Orlando** garages, while dining and shopping in **Downtown Orlando**. - To help track the differences across each state and provide the latest guidance and information to America’s employers, the **U.S. Chamber of Commerce** has launched [an interactive map and state-by-state guide](#).
- **Orlando Health** has launched [a new website specifically designed for those in the business community returning to normal operations](#). The site features tips and

best practices from medical experts, including facts about COVID-19, proper hand washing, surface cleaning, mask wearing, social distancing and self-screening.

- After a month of providing drive-up COVID-19 testing in seven counties, **AdventHealth** [will begin phasing out the screening over the next two weeks](#) as the state of Florida and businesses reopen. Testing will continue to be available with a doctor's order at **Centra Care** locations and for patients at **AdventHealth** hospitals.
- The following **COVID-19 testing sites** are open to anyone exhibiting symptoms of the virus, healthcare providers and first responders, and anyone who has had close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19, regardless of symptoms.

- **Orange County Government's Health Services Division** continues their free COVID19 testing site(s) this week. There is no criteria for testing, but appointments are required and individuals must be 18+ and an Orange County resident. - **The Florida Department of Health in Orange County** announced several mobile testing sites for **May 11-15**. Call 407-723-5004 from 8am to 5pm, or leave a message to receive a call back. [Testing sites will be located at Independence Elementary in Winter Garden, Olympia High School, Camping World Stadium, Evans High School and Prairie Lake Elementary.](#)
- The **City of Orlando** opened a drive-thru COVID-19 testing site in partnership with **Quest Diagnostics, Walmart** and state agencies. Testing will take place in the parking lot of **Walmart** on Goldenrod Road, and is only for those exhibiting symptoms of the virus, as well as all healthcare providers and first responders in the Orlando community. - **National Guard** jets will fly over Orlando and other parts of Central Florida on **Wednesday, May 13** [to honor health workers and first responders](#) fighting the coronavirus outbreak. See graphic below for the complete schedule.

Around The Horn.

- From **Yahoo Sports**: There were masks on faces around the Octagon. There were no fans in the stands. [Someone had to be first](#), and the **UFC** was willing to do it.
- **Rory McIlroy, Dustin Johnson, Rickie Fowler** and **Matthew Wolff** will compete in **TaylorMade Driving Relief**, [a team best-ball skins match](#) with all proceeds going to support COVID-19 relief.
- On a recent call with the **National Basketball Players Association**, **NBA Commissioner Adam Silver** said [returning to play this season at one or two potential sites](#) - including Orlando and Las Vegas - makes the most sense.

- **Major League Baseball** owners agreed to make a proposal to the players' union that [could lead to the delayed season starting around the Fourth of July weekend](#) in ballparks without fans. Spring training would start in early to mid-June.
- **B.A.S.S.** officials [have announced a new schedule for the remainder of 2020](#) designed to ensure all Bassmaster Elite Series and Basspro.com Bassmaster Open tournaments can be completed.
- Sources say the **NHL** has narrowed 'return-to-play' plans [down to two scenarios](#).
- The **PGA's** upcoming **Memorial Tournament** in mid-July [will make use of a radio frequency identification chip in event badges](#) to help maintain spacing of patrons.
- **Florida Tech** announced [it is eliminating its football program](#) due to the economic strain caused by the coronavirus pandemic.
- **Major League Soccer** is continuing to evaluate multiple potential scenarios for returning to play. [Sources say the most likely format is a tournament held at a single location or multiple regional locations](#) over the course of about 45 days. A handful of potential host cities are being evaluated, including **Orlando**, Dallas, Los Angeles and Kansas City, among others.
- **Fox Sports Florida** is continuing with its schedule to replay some of the most memorable wins in **Orlando Magic** history, as [more games have been added to the May broadcasting schedule](#).
- **U.S. Women's National Team** and **Orlando Pride** star **Alex Morgan** and husband **Servando Carrasco** [welcomed their first child last week](#).
- As the **NCAA** works to finalize its rules allowing athletes to get compensation for use of their image and likeness, [college athletes' social media fame could be the quickest way](#) they cash in on changes expected to be implemented in 2021.

In The News.

- A phased reopening of **Disney Springs** will begin on **May 20**. Following the guidance of government and health officials, [a limited number of shopping and dining experiences that are owned by third-party operating participants](#) will begin to open during this initial phase.
- Shortly after the state-wide shutdown began, local printer **Impress Ink** launched an online t-shirt shop to raise funds for local businesses and the **Second Harvest Food Bank of Central Florida**. The first month's numbers are in, and [they've raised \\$30,228 since launching](#). (P.S. shirts are still available at [OrlandoMerchStore.com](#))

- The **Florida Department of Transportation** will [shut down all but one, westbound lane](#) of **Interstate 4** between Princeton Street to the north and Gore Street to the south from the evening of Wednesday, May 13 to the morning of Monday, May 18. All westbound lanes may be closed intermittently at night during the weekend.

The 125th Fighter Wing will fly over the city of Orlando on Wednesday, May 13th, as a salute to healthcare workers and first responders who have been on the forefront of the fight against COVID-19.
