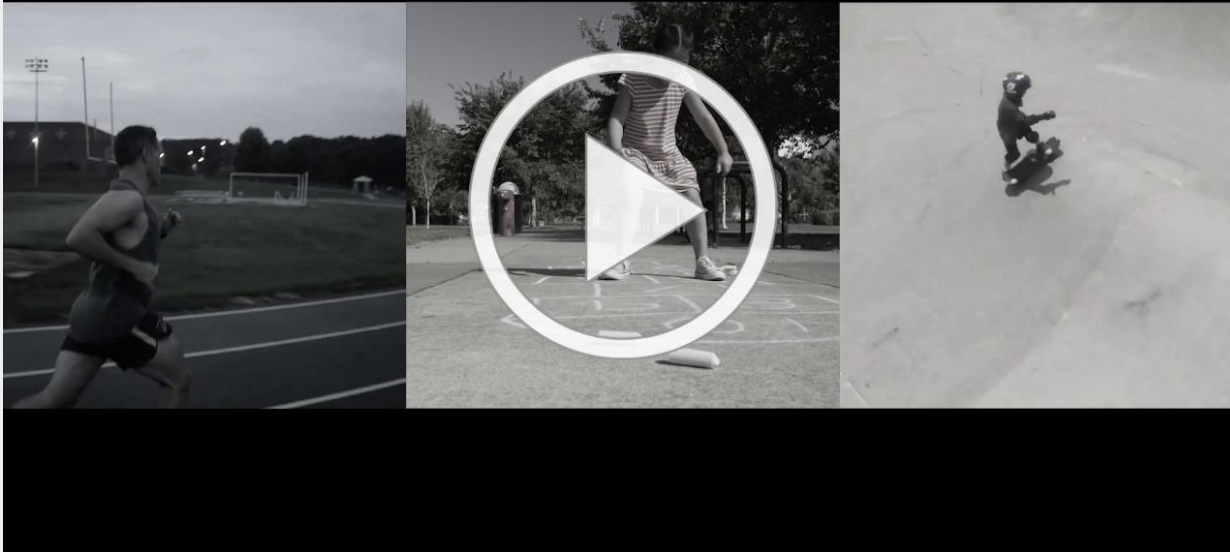




Impact Update for Tuesday, May 26

- The **Orange County Economic Recovery Task Force** [announced seven guidelines](#) for reopening businesses and industries in the Orlando region. **Orange County** has also [developed re-opening criteria for restaurants in unincorporated Orange County](#).
- **Orlando Mayor Buddy Dyer** announced a package of actions that are effective immediately in the **City of Orlando**, providing opportunities for [businesses to temporarily expand their operational space and market their businesses outside](#), without the need to obtain city permits or pay any fees.
- As part of the **Federal CARES Act**, **Orange County Government** has received \$243 million in Coronavirus Relief Funds. [These funds will be distributed back into the community, and used for local government expenses](#) related to the response to COVID-19. **Orange County** is working to finalize program details, and will make an announcement on their website, through the media, and on social media prior to officially opening up the program to applicants.
- In order to help [residents navigate tenant rights, evictions and other housing assistance information for COVID-19](#), **Orange County** has put together a list of answers to [frequently asked questions](#) on these topics.
- Now through **September 1**, patrons can enjoy FREE parking in metered street spaces and inside specific **City of Orlando** garages, while dining and shopping in **Downtown Orlando**. - The following **COVID-19 testing sites** are open to **any Orange County resident** over the age of 18. There is no criteria for being tested, but appointments are required.

- **OneBlood** is now testing all blood donations for the COVID-19 antibody. The test is authorized by the **Food and Drug Administration (FDA)** and will indicate if the donor's immune system has produced antibodies to the virus, regardless of whether they ever showed symptoms. Around The Horn.

- As the nation confronts the health and economic crisis brought on by the coronavirus, **Mayor Buddy Dyer** confirmed that [Orlando is indeed “in the mix” to host the re-start](#) of both the **NBA** and **MLS** seasons but says “nothing is set in stone” just yet.

- **Elite Clubs National League** has launched the **ECNL Return to Play Recommendations** as a [free resource to support the health and safety of players](#) across the nation's youth soccer landscape of more than three million players.
- **Microsoft** and **Special Olympics** are teaming up for the **2020 Special Olympics Xbox Virtual Gaming Event** featuring **Turn 10 Studios' Forza Motorsport 7**. [Eleven US states will be represented with over 35 athletes participating.](#)
- New **UCF** co-offensive coordinator **Alex Golesh** has tried to make the most of [videoconference tools to help build relationships](#) with recruits, as coaches adapt to not being able to have conversations in person or give recruits and their families tours of campus.
- The **Centers for Disease Control and Prevention** has created guidance to consider when **youth sports** return to play. The document includes tips for assessing risk, measures that can reduce spread and maintain healthy environments, and what to do if someone gets sick. [Read the Guidelines here.](#)
- The **NBA**, in conjunction with the **National Basketball Players Association**, confirmed they are [engaged in exploratory conversations with The Walt Disney Company about restarting the 2019-20 NBA season in late July](#) at **Disney's ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex**.
- The **NHL** and the **NHLPA** have [agreed to a format that would give 24 teams the opportunity to close out the season](#) by heading straight into post-season play.
- The **MLB Players' Association** [has submitted a response](#) to **MLB's** 67-page health and safety protocol proposal for a potential 2020 season. The league is now expected to initiate discussions on a financial plan.
- **Orlando City** will be a No. 1 seed if **Major League Soccer** can [clear all the hurdles needed to resume play with a tournament](#) at **ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex**, according to **The Athletic**.
- There's a lot of uncertainty surrounding the **2020 NFL season**, but the league is planning to host games as normal. The **NFL** is [currently operating as if stadiums will be packed with fans once the 2020 season gets underway](#), according to **NBC Sports Washington**.
- **Orlando Magic** forward **Jonathan Isaac** says he feels calling to help others during the pandemic, as he [continues to juggle his work to rehabilitate his injured left knee with his commitment to helping](#) the Central Florida community.
- The **USTA** has [shared guidelines nationwide to help people feel comfortable](#) with playing tennis safely during the coronavirus pandemic.
- On Monday, the **Orlando Pride** held their first small group training session since March 13. The **NWSL** is [now allowing all teams to participate in small group training](#) as long as they follow safety protocol.
- The **Amateur Athletic Union** has signed esports production company **Rival** to be a national operating partner of the **AAU Esports program**. [AAU esports events will run on Rival's tournament management software starting this summer.](#)

- **World TeamTennis** will compress its 2020 season into [a three-week, single-site event featuring nine teams starting July 12](#) at a resort in West Virginia. They are planning to allow up to 500 spectators at outdoor matches.
- The **Nippon Professional Baseball** league in **Japan** announced its season will begin June 19, the [league announced Monday after receiving official approval from its government](#) to start playing without fans in attendance.
- The **Pensacola Blue Wahoos**, the Double-A affiliate of the **Minnesota Twins**, have placed their stadium on **AirBnB**. For \$1,500 per night, [guests staying at the ballpark will have full access to the clubhouse, a large bedroom with 10 beds, the batting cage, and the field itself.](#)
- **Tiger Woods** and **Peyton Manning** took home bragging rights from Sunday's "The Match: Champions for Charity" against **Phil Mickelson** and **Tom Brady**, but the foursome delivered a hole in one for tournament organizers and **Turner**. With 5.8 million average viewers across **TNT, TBS, truTV** and **HLN**, [the program became the most-watched golf event ever on cable TV.](#)
