- Last week, **Florida Governor Ron DeSantis** announced that Phase One of the reopening process would begin on Monday, May 4. The state has compiled an [FAQ sheet](#) related to that executive order.
- The **Orange County Economic Recovery Task Force** [announced seven guidelines](#) for the reopening of businesses and industries in the Orlando region. After consulting with the Sheriff and Police Chiefs, **Orange County** said the 11 pm to 5am curfew will remain in effect through this week, and then the County will reassess.
- **Orange County Government** has [developed re-opening criteria for restaurants in unincorporated Orange County](#).
- **Orlando Mayor Buddy Dyer** announced the **City of Orlando** is advancing a package of actions that are effective immediately, providing opportunities for [businesses to temporarily expand their operational space and market their businesses outside](#), without the need to obtain city permits or pay any fees.
- To help track the differences across each state and provide the latest guidance and information to America’s employers, the **U.S. Chamber of Commerce** has launched [an interactive map and state-by-state guide](#).
- **Orlando Health** has launched [a new website specifically designed for those in the business community returning to normal operations](#). The site features tips and

best practices from medical experts, including facts about COVID-19, proper hand washing, surface cleaning, mask wearing, social distancing and self-screening.

Testing will take place in the parking lot of **Walmart** on Goldenrod Road, and is only for those exhibiting symptoms of the virus, as well as all healthcare providers and first responders in the Orlando community.
