- [State of Florida Full Phase One Reopening Guidelines](#)
- Until further notice, **Orange County** and the **City of Orlando** have a [curfew in effect](#) from **10pm to 5am**.
- **Orange County Government** has received \$243.2 million in **Federal CARES Act** funding. The County's [Small Business Grant Program](#) will provide \$10,000 in grant money to small businesses located in **Orange County** to help offset lost revenue due to COVID-19, and the [Individual and Family Assistance Program](#) for residents will provide a one-time payment of \$1,000 per household to bridge financial gaps for overdue rent, mortgage, medical or an eligible utility expense. Applications for businesses and individuals will open on **Monday, June 8**.
- The **Downtown Development Board** approved an amendment to its existing Special Event Funding program. [The program will now provide up to \\$3,000 to qualifying downtown businesses](#) to support reopening marketing efforts.
- **Seminole County** has [announced more details of a grant program designed to aid small businesses](#) struggling amid the economic downturn caused by the coronavirus pandemic. Under the program, which launches on **June 1**, small businesses in **Seminole County** can receive up to \$5,000 in aid.
- **Orange County Government** will [distribute reusable cloth masks to small businesses](#) on **June 4 & 5**. Businesses must register and schedule an appointment.
- The **Orange County Economic Recovery Task Force** [announced seven guidelines](#) for reopening businesses and industries in the Orlando region. **Orange County** has also [developed re-opening criteria for restaurants in unincorporated Orange County](#).
- **Orlando Mayor Buddy Dyer** announced a package of actions that are effective immediately in the **City of Orlando**, providing opportunities for [businesses to temporarily expand their operational space and market their businesses outside](#), without the need to obtain city permits or pay any fees.
- **Governor Ron DeSantis** extended the state's [moratorium on evictions and foreclosures](#) to **Wednesday, July 1**.
- In order to help [residents navigate tenant rights, evictions and other housing assistance information for COVID-19](#), **Orange County** has put together a list of answers to [frequently asked questions](#) on these topics.
- Now through **September 1**, patrons can enjoy FREE parking in metered street spaces and inside specific **City of Orlando** garages, while dining and shopping in **Downtown Orlando**. Around The Horn.

- **Electronic Arts** has signed a multiyear renewal with the **NFL** and the **NFL Players Association** that will see the game publisher continue the **Madden NFL** franchise and also [work more closely with the league and players to grow football fandom.](#)
- The **National Women’s Soccer League** announced [the full schedule for the preliminary rounds](#) of the **2020 NWSL Challenge Cup** presented by P&G and Secret. The 25-game tournament will kick off on **June 27** in Utah.
- The **Orlando Pride** will face the **Chicago Red Stars**, **Portland Thorns**, **North Carolina Courage** and **Sky Blue FC** in the [preliminary rounds after drawing the nine-seed](#) for the **2020 NWSL Challenge Cup**. Kickoff times and broadcast details for specific matches will be announced at a later date.
- The **NBA** is planning a Thursday vote of the league's board of governors - with owners expected to approve **Commissioner Adam Silver's** [recommendation on a format to restart the season in Orlando](#), sources tell **ESPN**.
- **Major League Baseball** and the **MLBPA** are now in their fourth week of talks concerning a return-to-play plan for a potential 2020 season. After some heated discussions last month, [it appears the two sides are getting closer to a deal.](#)

- The commissioners of the **Power 5 conferences** have [sent a letter to congressional leaders asking for federal legislation to govern pay for college athletes](#). The letter, signed by the commissioners of the **ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, Pac-12, and SEC**, outlines the **NCAA's** priorities for name, image and likeness compensation while also requesting an anti-trust exemption and a national law.
- What is the **GBAC Star Facility Accreditation** and why is it important? [Facilities and venues are working on program's accreditation to ensure attendee safety](#).
- Among the scenarios being considered for the **2020 U.S. Open** are [charter flights to ferry the tennis players and limited entourages from Europe, South America and the Middle East to New York, COVID-19 tests before traveling](#), centralized housing, daily temperature checks, fewer on-court officials, no spectators and no locker-room access on practice days.
- The **National Basketball Coaches Association** has [established a committee on racial injustice and reform](#) to pursue solutions within **NBA** cities. **Gregg Popovich, Steve Kerr, Lloyd Pierce, David Fizdale and Stan Van Gundy** were among the coaches selected.
- **Feld Entertainment Inc.** will bring the **Monster Energy AMA Supercross** series back to action this Sunday. The remainder of the schedule - seven races in total - [will be held at the same venue in Salt Lake City](#) and will be broadcast on **NBC** networks.
- **Major League Baseball** [confirmed that Omaha will not host](#) the **MLB Draft** this year. The draft will instead be held on **June 10 & 11** at **MLB Network** studios in Secaucus, New Jersey.
- Last week, the second annual **espnW Summit NYC** went virtual and brought together more than 14,000 (!) industry members. If you weren't able to join live, **ESPN** has [posted each segment as individual video clips](#) so you can watch them at your convenience.
- **US Lacrosse** [released its return-to-play guidelines](#) that consist of a five-stage process varying by region. Allowances from state and local public health officials will guide the decision-making to move from one stage to the next.
- **Wes Unseld**, who passed away at the age of 74, [spent more than three decades in the NBA as a player, coach and executive](#). Along with **Wilt Chamberlain**, he is one of two players to win the league's MVP award in his rookie season, and was named one of the **NBA's 50 Greatest Players** during their 50th anniversary celebration.
- From **ESPN**: [How the trust between Adam Silver and Chris Paul will shape the NBA's restart](#).
- **Notre Dame** football will not open the season against **Navy** in Dublin, Ireland on August 29 as originally scheduled, [but the teams will face each other in Annapolis, Maryland](#), most likely on Labor Day weekend.
