- The majority of the state is now in **Phase 2** of the **State of Florida Re-opening Plan**. [Click here](#) for a summary, or [click here](#) to read the full Executive Order.
- **Orange County Mayor Jerry Demings** has [signed an executive order that makes it mandatory for people in the county to wear facial coverings](#) until further notice. Anyone working, living, visiting or doing business in **Orange County** will need to wear facial coverings consistent to **CDC guidelines** in public spaces.
- The **PPE for Small Biz in Orange County Initiative** provides free personal protective equipment to small businesses (40 or fewer employees) in **Orange County** to assist in safe reopening or sustaining operations. Distribution is being offered **June 24-26** from 9am-4:30pm at three pick-up locations around the county. An appointment is required and [can be made online here](#).
- **Orange County Government** has received \$243.2 million in **Federal CARES Act** funding. The County's [Small Business Grant Program](#) will provide \$10,000 in grant money to small businesses located in **Orange County** to help offset lost revenue due to COVID-19, and the [Individual and Family Assistance Program](#) for residents will provide a one-time payment of \$1,000 per household to bridge financial gaps for overdue rent, mortgage, medical or an eligible utility expense.
 - **The Small Business Grant Program portal** is currently [accepting applications](#). Eligibility requirements were recently expanded to include businesses who received \$50k or less funding from PPP & companies with 100 or less employees.

- The **Downtown Development Board** approved an amendment to its existing Special Event Funding program. [The program will now provide up to \\$3,000 to qualifying downtown businesses](#) to support reopening marketing efforts. [Apply for funding here.](#)
- **Governor Ron DeSantis** extended the state's [moratorium on evictions and foreclosures](#) to **Wednesday, July 1.**
- In order to help [residents navigate tenant rights, evictions and other housing assistance information for COVID-19](#), **Orange County** has put together a list of answers to [frequently asked questions](#) on these topics.
- Now through **September 1**, patrons can enjoy FREE parking in metered street spaces and inside specific **City of Orlando** garages, while dining and shopping in **Downtown Orlando**. - **OneBlood** is now testing all blood donations for the COVID-19 antibody. The test is authorized by the **Food and Drug Administration (FDA)** and will indicate if the donor's immune system has produced antibodies to the virus, regardless of whether they ever showed symptoms. - For the first time since 1942, the nation's premier junior tennis tournament won't be held in Southwest Michigan, as the **United States Tennis Association** [announced the annual event will move](#) to **Orlando, Florida** on **August 7-15, 2020**.
- **Shaquille O'Neal** and **Rob Gronkowski** are throwing a "party with a purpose" this weekend. The four-time NBA champion will face off against the three-time Super Bowl victor in six live challenges—[ranging from an eating contest to a lip sync battle](#)—to raise donations for two social justice organizations. **O'Neal** and **Gronkowski** will face off in real time and the winner will earn funds for a charity of their choice. - **Australia and New Zealand** [have beaten Colombia to win the bid](#) to host the **2023 FIFA Women's World Cup**.
- The **2020 New York City Marathon** has been canceled. The decision to shutter the race, [which is the world's largest marathon and one of the city's marquee events](#), was due to "coronavirus-related health and safety concerns," according to a statement from the organizer, **New York Road Runners**.
- **Major League Soccer** released its tournament schedule two weeks before the opening match, [unveiling a rule change that could benefit Orlando City](#).
- **ACC commissioner John Swofford** announced he will retire after the 2020-21 season. **Swofford** helped guide the **Atlantic Coast Conference** for more than two decades, [expanding not only the league's footprint but its brand recognition](#).
- As the **NBA** eases back into operation after shutting down due to the coronavirus pandemic, [coaches were allowed to work with players for the first time](#) this week and **Orlando Magic coach Steve Clifford** was eager to reunite with his players.
- **Orlando City** will enter the bubble at **Disney** today to begin its final stage of training ahead of its first match in the **MLS is Back Tournament**. For head coach **Oscar Pareja**, [the return of soccer couldn't come soon enough](#).

- **USA Triathlon** announced that the rescheduled **2020 Toyota USA Paratriathlon National Championships** [will be held on September 20 in Cocoa Beach, Florida](#) as part of the **Ron Jon Cocoa Beach Triathlon**.
- **Formula One's Esports Virtual Grands Prix** achieved 30 million views across TV and digital platforms during the coronavirus-enforced lockdown period, [the global motorsport racing series has revealed.](#)
- **Conference USA** has joined the **SEC** and **NCAA** in [prohibiting championship tournaments in Mississippi](#) until the state changes its flag.
- **DreamHack** [announced the launch of a new tournament series](#) called **DreamHack Open Featuring Fortnite**. A prize pool of \$250,000 will be up for grabs every month the tournament will be broadcast live on **Twitch**.

In The News.

- **Governor Ron DeSantis** signed a bill that he said will boost pay for many teachers, [making the minimum salary among the highest in the nation](#). The goal is to have teachers, on average, earn at least \$47,500.
- **Disney** will revamp its **Splash Mountain** log rides [with the new theme of “The Princess and the Frog.”](#) The change will happen at both **Magic Kingdom** theme park and at **Disneyland** in California.
- Orlando-based **Darden Restaurants** [has brought back 60,000 of about 150,000 furloughed restaurant workers](#) as it recovers from the coronavirus pandemic. At least another 40,000 restaurant workers are expected to return to work as business continues to improve, **CEO Gene Lee** said.
- Plans to reopen **Disneyland Resort in California** [have been postponed](#), but the schedule for the phased reopening of **Walt Disney World** has not changed, a **Disney World** spokeswoman said.
- **SeaWorld’s Aquatica Orlando** water park will resume daily operation July 2, [while offering a limited-time discount of more than 40 percent](#) on select single-day tickets.
